Jimmy Waddell serves in Sinaloa, Mexico at a Christian school. He works as a PE teacher, maintenance man and prepares texts. His wife, Dulce, teaches kindergarten and first grade. They are also involved in ministry with their church and The Pinguicas, the ministry to the homeless. From late fall to early spring they evangelize at the migrant camps. Pray for them as they minister in a very dangerous region of Mexico and for their 2 young children.


New Beginnings Pregnancy and Parent Center in Payson, AZ is a pro-life Christian non-profit organization. Last year they moved into a larger building, so they have been able to expand. They provide pregnancy testing; education on parenting, sexual purity, pre-natal care, adoption and STD's; and "earn while you learn" to get necessities after completing classes. They have also been able to minister to fathers now. Please pray that more volunteers will sign up.

The Payson Christian Clinic in Payson, AZ shares the love of Christ through providing whole-person healthcare to the medically underserved. They also train medical professionals in whole-person care and network with the medical community, churches, civic organizations and government agencies. There is a need for more volunteers such as medical professionals, reception, medical records and janitorial. Prayer and financial donations are also needed.

Serve India Ministries sends national pastors out to spread the gospel. India has more unreached people than any other country. There are many national pastors who have had very little training, but it is more effectual to send them out than foreign missionaries who have financial, cultural and linguistic barriers. The National pastors are trained over a 5 year period. They are given the goal of reaching 5 unreached villages in 5 years. After 5 years, financial support is discontinued so dependency is not created. The goal for SIM is to reach 100,000 villages by 2021. SIM also has an after school tutoring program where the impoverished children receive help with school, hygiene and are taught the love of Jesus.

Skate Park's Unfolding in Payson, AZ ministers to the youth at the Skate Park at Rumsey Park. Every Thursday they have food, Bible teaching and the love of Christ poured out. Pray for Scott, Amber, Marie, Mark & Alexis. There have been some souls won for Christ, but the enemy provides many distractions at the park.

The Hope House and Hope Center in Payson, AZ is transitional living for men and women who struggle with addiction or find themselves in a dark place in life. This is a structured program where the residents work and then go to church and recovery groups. Pray for Joe, the Director, and the rest of the Board, and the people who have matured in the program who are helping manage the program.
